

Virginia Workers' Compensation Commission (VWC) Announcement VWC FROI SROI – Version 5.0.9 Available for Download and VWC Implementing Acceptance of 2022 NAICS Change Effective August 1, 2022

VWC has posted the VWC FROI/SROI R3 EDI Requirements Version 5.0.9 (Revision Date: 1/24/2022, Effective Date: 08/01/2022). The requirements are immediately available for download on the VWC EDI Implementation Guide and Requirements page. The 'Track Changes Document' describes the changes to VWC's Requirements.

Industry Code 2007/2012/2017/2022 List - Edit based on Date of Injury

In Virginia, the edit on DN0025 Industry Code utilizes DN0031 Date of Injury in conjunction with NAICS code list. Effective August 1, 2022, VWC will be Implementing acceptance of 2022 NAICS that will be required on claims that have Date of Injury (DN0031) greater than or equal to 08/01/2022. Please refer to the edit as shown below.

DN0025 Industry Code for Error 042 Not Statutorily Valid Edit:

- If DN0031 Date of Injury < 10/20/2014, then refer to and validate against the 2007 NAICS Codes
- If DN0031 Date of Injury > = 10/20/2014 and < 05/01/2017, then refer to and validate against the 2012 NAICS Codes
- If DN0031 Date of Injury > = 05/01/2017 and < 08/01/2022, then refer to and validate against the 2017 NAICS Codes
- If DN0031 Date of Injury > = 08/01/2022 then refer to and validate against the 2022 NAICS Codes.

Note: VWC will accept valid 4, 5 or 6 digit NAICS Codes.
