VWC Bulletin: Updated VWC FROI/SROI R3 EDI Requirements Version 5.0.5 Available for Download

VWC has posted an updated version of the VWC FROI/SROI R3 EDI Requirements Version 5.0.5. The requirements are immediately available for download on the VWC EDI Implementation Guide and Requirements page. Please go to www.vwcedi.info and select 'Implementation Guide' under EDI Resources on the left hand side of the page.

Summary of Updated Changes: VWC Version 5.0.5 changes include the following as represented on the updated Track Changes Log under Items 5.0.5.100 through 5.0.5.103.

- Item 5.0.5.100 change planned for October 2016: For existing requirement: Edit Matrix Population Restriction: SROI MTC UR should only be sent when Date of Injury (DN0031) is < 10/1/2008.
- Items 5.0.5.101 through 5.0.5.103: Correction: Element Requirement Tables for FROI, SROI and SROI UR: VWC initially updated to utilize the new AA, AE and AR Requirement Codes. VWC has made a correction to update the AA (previously set to IA which returns TR acknowledgment) requirement code across the board to AR (If Applicable/Available Transaction Rejected).). This change from AA (previous IA) to AR will not result in any edit changes as VWC's use of the IA requirement code has always returned a TR acknowledgment when the data is available or sent and is invalid.

Summary of Changes Previously Presented: VWC Version 5.0.5 include the changes as indicated by the IAIABC for Claims Release 3.0 Guide, January 1, 2016 Publication. In addition, effective 12-15-16 VWC will no longer accept DN0074 Claim Type Code and will begin to accept DN0229 Injury Severity Type Code.
