



## Virginia Workers' Compensation Commission (VWC) Announcement

### **VWC is revising existing EDI Claims Version R3.1 Element Requirement Condition for DN0077 Late Reason Code, DN0036-Part of Body Injured Code DN0083-Permanent Impairment Body Part Code and DN0212-Non-Consecutive Period Code.**

The Virginia Workers' Compensation Commission (VWC) is revising R3.1 Element Requirement Conditions for DN0077 Late Reason Code, DN0036-Part of Body Injured Code and DN0083-Permanent Impairment Body Part Code that was made effective immediately.

The following are the revision that will be made:

- For FROI MTC 00, DN0077 Late Reason Code is required if Date Transmission Sent (DN0100) is greater than 30 days after Date Claim Admin Had Knowledge of Injury (DN0041) AND a R3.0 FROI MTC UR (g) or R3.0 FROI MTC 04 was not previously accepted/does not exist for the JCN.
  - The change will resolve the rejections our submitters are receiving when attempting to file a FROI 00 in Release 3.1 after it was reported as a minor on a FROI UR in Release 3.0.
- For FROI 00 or AU, DN0036-Part of Body Injured Code is required if Injury Severity Type Code (DN0229) = J for Major Injury OR if DN0421 Part of Body Injured Location Code or DN0422 Part of Body Injured Fingers/Toes Location Code is present. is required if if DN0421 Part of Body Injured Location Code or DN0422 Part of Body Injured Fingers/Toes Location Code is present.
  - This change is being implemented because we are seeing several instance of transactions being reported with just the Location Code and not the actual Part of Body Code. The same is true for the below bullet with Permanent Impairment Location Code.
- For SROI Conditions, refer to SROI ERT for MC value for DN0083-Permanent Impairment Body Part Code revised condition to indicate this is required if DN0084 Permanent Impairment Percentage or DN0432 Permanent Impairment Body Part Location Code is present.
- Revised SROI condition for DN0212-Non-Consecutive Period Code to indicate Do Not Apply edit if Benefit Type Code/Payment Reason Code = 5xx" Exception as DN0090-Benefit Type Claim Weeks and DN0091-Benefit Type Claim Days cannot be required when Benefit Type Code = 5XX.
